Located on bluffs overlooking the Willamette Falls, Oregon City was the destination for thousands of Oregon Trail pioneer settlers in the 1840s. Today, its rich heritage and natural beauty, and its identity as the City at the End of the Oregon continues to lure visitors seeking a direct connection to the nation's pioneer past.

TDM developed a strategy that provided directions for the city's museums, attractions and tourism interests to work in a more integrated manner. This has now culminated in a single organization that is overseeing the management of the museums, transport and heritage attractions in a more cohesive manner. This includes the Historic Oregon City Pass which provides one ticket entry to the End of the Oregon Trail Interpretive Center, the Museum of the Oregon Territory, and the Stevens Crawford House.
